Experience in areas like broadcast traffic/automation software (ProTrack, Harmonic), video editing, IP networking and digital video facilities maintenance is a plus, but we are willing to train.

Key Responsibilities:

- Daily broadcast traffic and automation
- Manages recorded media and interstitial content
- Oversees media inventory and remote production kits
- Monitors broadcast signals
- Assists with video productions
- Performs other job-related duties as assigned
